3. Knockout Competitions

Turnout was good. Competition rules have been clarified to state that you must have played a 1/3rd of your teams fixtures to be able to play for your divisions competitions. (i.e. not for another division)

4. Postponements

Clarification given to postponement rule. Extraordinary circumstances are those circumstances that effect a teams as a whole (such as extreme weather) or venue availability (such as powercuts or floods). Not having enough players is not a valid reason to be exempt from penalty (with exception of the first occurrence providing more than 24 hours notice is given)

5. Social Media

The committee asked that people be sensible with comments made on social media, as individuals may be held to account and possibly be banned from the league

6. Bonus Point

The committee discussed the proposal to introduce a bonus point system for winning teams. It was decided that the current scoring system was the fairest as each point would hold the same value. The circumstance which occurred this season with a team winning all matches, but not winning the league or even promotion is a rare occurrence.

7. Tendering Challenge

After the success of the inaugural event last year, the MDDL has invited The Tendering Darts league to play the return fixture this season. The date has provisionally been set for Saturday 29th July and will be held at Maldon Town FC (this will be confirmed closer to the time).

Players who attended the first event will be given the first chance to make the team. For any additional spots, please register your interest by emailing the league secretary.
